Membership renewals:

Club membership renewals and Radio Licence contributions are due for payment at the end of March. Membership renewal fees will again remain unchanged as they have for some years now. While we see no reason to increase membership fees we do face an ongoing annual increase in radio licences charged by ACMA. These increases have been absorbed by the club over recent years however this year the committee has decided we need to make an increase the proportion of the licence fees that are passed on to members. After the increase the new fee contribution will be \$40.00 per member. As the majority of our club's income comes from car rally events we will also be increasing the discount offered to those who attend these events so as to fully offset the increase. Members attending 2 or more events in the year will see no change in their annual fees. As usual members attending events and with adequate money in their fuel account will have their membership renewed automatically. Members without sufficient money in their fuel account will receive a renewal notice by email giving details of membership fee and radio usage if applicable. If you wish to make any changes to your membership type or need to update your information held with the club, it will greatly assist your secretary if you let him know by emailing omega.radio.club@gmail.com as soon as possible. Don't forget, as our VHF radio licences are all held by the club, to be covered by these licences you must be a current financial club member.
